Open Program: All activity areas (except COPE & Waterskiing) are open to all Scouts.

HORSE RIDES are offered daily at 3:30 pm. Sign up and pay in the trading post.

Troop Time Activities: SPL signs up for these activities at SPL Council and the Troop does them together:

ARCHERY: Troop Shoot at the Archery Range

BIKING: Check out the camp bikes for a trip to the lake

CLIMBING: Climbing on the Tower

LOW & HIGH COPE: Each session takes an hour to an hour and a half. Available during Open Program and Troop Time.

ORIENTEERING RACE: Troop members test their skills as a group or against each other

PIONEERING: Two words - tower power

POOL: Learn to Snorkel or just enjoy the pool

RIFLE RANGE: Shoot the 22 Rifles, or Shotgun or Black Powder your choice

WATERSKIING: Enjoy waterskiing at bumping lake during Open Program and Troop Time - Extra Cost

Adventure Day Activities: Adventure Day is a day to get out of camp and go hiking. All of the Troop Time Activities are available.

CLIMBING: Off-site rock climbing - the climbing tower will be closed during the day

HALF DAY HIKES: Hikes to various peaks around camp with the goal to use signal mirrors to contact each other at pre set time

HORSE RIDES: Take the Troop for a ride, 10 people at a time - Extra Cost

MT BALDY HIKE: This is an all day hike in a wilderness area - groups of 12 people

MT RAINIER EXCURSION: Explore the majesty of Mt Rainier

Outpost Excursions: Register at the Trading Post at Camp

CANOE OUTPOST: Troops sign up to use the camp canoes and go after dinner for an overnight adventure

HORSE OUTPOST: Offered Monday and Tuesday Nights. Requires two adults to sign up

WILDERNESS SURVIVAL: Part of Wilderness Survival Merit Badge
