CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP 2010



Cub Scout Day Camps are offered throughout the summer in various geographical areas of the council. This program, which usually runs three days (there are some two day camps), offers a fun-filled camp of challenging Cub Scout activities, exciting adventures and new friendships. If your son will be in the 1st – 5th Grade in **September of 2010**, join us for Day Camp this year as we celebrate with a “Cubs Down Under” theme. Going to Cub Scout Day Camp with friends from your own Den or Pack really increases the fun for everyone! Dens are formed according to age and school grade. In order to ensure adequate adult supervision, individual Packs are urged to coordinate their attendance at Day Camp, including early recruitment of Day Camp leadership and transportation.

Cub Scouts participate in many types of activities which may include archery, arts and crafts, BB guns, field sports, nature, Scout skills, swimming and a variety of other events. All areas (especially archery, BB guns and swimming) place a special emphasis on safety procedures with trained station leaders. Please visit our website at www.grandcolumbiabsa.org for specific camp information and come to your camp’s spring training to find out what will be offered at your camp. Cub Scout advancement is included in the program although we “disguise” it as part of the fun! Safe fun is the main goal of camp!



♦ **WHAT TO BRING:** Each day Cub Scouts should bring a water bottle (fill at home), towel (if swimming), rain gear, and a sack lunch that does not require refrigeration. Be sure the Cub Scout’s name is on everything that he brings to camp.

♦ **WHAT TO WEAR:** Shorts or cool pants, t-shirt and tennis shoes (**No Sandals or Crocs**). Spray with bug repellent and apply sunscreen before leaving home.

Youth who wish to attend but are not registered with the Scouting program are welcome! **You must be registered by the Early Bird Deadline to be guaranteed a t-shirt on the first day of your camp.** To be considered registered you must have the registration and health form completed and signed, and total fees paid. Camperships and partial campership awards are available for Scouts who do not have the ability to pay. Contact the Scout office or visit the website at www.grandcolumbiabsa.org for a campership application. **The deadline for camp scholarships is May 15, 2010.** All camps are on a first-come, first-served basis.

♦ **VOLUNTEER FOR STAFF:** (You might even have fun yourself!) To ensure a successful Day Camp program for our Cub Scouts, volunteers are needed at camp to assist the staff and guide the Cubs through each day’s activities. The volunteer staff is comprised of a Camp Director, Program Director, Program Staff (Station Leaders), Den Walkers and Assistants, and additional support staff as needed. All these positions are filled by volunteers. Day Camp can not happen without your help. New volunteers are always welcome and appreciated. Please complete a separate registration form for each participant, including volunteers.

ATTENTION SCOUT SIBLINGS!

Hey, kids - - is your brother going to day camp and you want to go also? We have exciting opportunities for you to participate in activities at camp, as long as a parent/ guardian of yours is at camp as a volunteer!

Tag-Along Lot: This is for brothers and sisters of Cub Scouts who are ages 3 years old (and potty trained) through 7 years old. You will have your own station, with all adult leadership, where activities designed specifically for this age group are planned. There will be games, crafts and snacks. The cost for being a Tag-Along is \$15 per camp or \$5 per day, but you **MUST** have a parent/guardian volunteering at camp for the times you are in the Tag-Along lot. Please check the information for the camp in your area to see if a Tag-Along lot is available.



Girls' Camp Experience: We are excited to introduce this new opportunity for sisters of Cub Scouts. This is designed specifically for Cub Scout sisters aged 8 years old through 11 years old. Girls will travel to the scout stations, just as their Cub Scout brothers do. In order for a girl to participate, a parent **MUST** be a volunteer in Camp while they attend. Only those girls attending on the first day camp for the required safety instruction will be permitted to shoot Archery and BB's. The cost of this program is the same as for Cub Scouts.
