REQUIRED ITEMS

- Scriptures
- Physical exam (completed and signed by your health care provider)
- Pack or duffel bag
- First aid kit (personal)
- Scout uniform, Varsity uniform, Venturing uniform as appropriate
- Shirts and t-shirts
- Pants
- Underwear
- Socks
- Jacket or sweatshirt or sweater – June could be cold at Fife, dress appropriately
- Hiking boots or hiking shoes
- Bike helmet if participating in biking events
- Light shoes
- Swim suit and swim towel
- Pajamas
- Raincoat or poncho
- Sleeping bag
- Ground cloth
- Camp Chair
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Air mattress or sleeping pad
- Canteen or water bottle
- Pencil and small notebook

- Hatchets
- Drugs or alcohol
- Plastic rope or twine
