## 2010 LDS Scout Encampment at Camp Fife June 21-26, 2010

### **Campsite Guidelines**

Because our encampment is very large, we will be camping “Jamboree style”. This means wards should be prepared to pitch their tents as closely to each other as the physical area allows. A dining/shade fly is recommended to provide a gathering place, shade, or cover from rain. The size of unit sites will be varied as the size of each ward is varied

Fires must be in existing fire pits or in above ground fire pans at least 10” above the ground. Please do not create additional fire pits or build fires on the ground. Meals will be provided in the dining hall, so you do not need to bring in your camp kitchen.

Please plan to carry all equipment to your assigned campsite. Equipment may be pre-positioned on Saturday, June 19, 2010 if desired.

At the completion of the Encampment all equipment, garbage, etc. must be removed. Units must check out their site with their stake representatives prior to leaving.

Please no digging or trenching.

Please leave all animal life alone. Wild animals are unpredictable and can be dangerous.

Please stay on camp property. Respect neighbors private property. Anyone found trespassing on private property will be asked to leave the Encampment.
