How to Sign up for the Jamboree

To submit an application for the 2010 National Scout Jamboree, go to www.MyScouting.org and log-in. After logging in, go to "Event Reservations" then "Jamboree." Choose the Youth Participant Application link. When submitting the application, there will be a \$10 non-refundable processing fee payable by credit card. This is not part of the jamboree fee.

When you complete your application on-line, print out your confirmation form, get your Scoutmaster's signature of approval, and then return the confirmation along with your \$100 deposit to either the Wenatchee or Yakima service center.

Refund Policy

If you sign up for the Jamboree and then find you cannot attend, you will receive a refund only if the council has an alternate to take your place.

Jamboree Fees

The fee for Jamboree participants is \$2,999.00. Fees include the Jamboree, pre/post-Jamboree tour including meals, lodging & transportation, equipment, and Jamboree participant package. This package will include 2 Jamboree t-shirts, 2 Jamboree council shoulder patches, Jamboree duffle bags, and more.
