What is

KODIAK X ?

Venturing's Nature of Leadership Program (NOL) is designed to develop the Venturer's leadership skills using exciting and fun leadership learning experiences. Phase 1 of NOL is the Venturing Leadership Skills course (VLSC), which covers three leadership skills. Phase 2, called **Kodiak**, is a six-day Venture trek-oriented course providing five leadership skills called commissions.

Phase 3 is the two-day long **Kodiak X**, which reinforces the skills learned in Kodiak, and adds two more commissions. **Kodiak X is only offered to those who have completed Kodiak.** Only phase 3 will be offered during this two day **Kodiak X** course.

Kodiak X does not involve a trek setting. **Kodiak X** builds upon those skills you learned in Kodiak. It is a challenge course. You will review the commissions learned in Kodiak. Each participant will then lead his or her group through a leadership challenge. You will learn two additional commissions.

The course prepares the Venturer to be a "servant leader" as you lead your crew. Servant leadership as a philosophy teaches that the leader works with and through a team to accomplish the mission. The course is designed to be relevant to the participant's life, to become internalized, is based on the servant leader concept, and most of all, it is **FUN!!**

The setting for this years' course is in Moses Lake, WA. Moses Lake is located on Interstate 90 about 3 hours East of Seattle, or 1.5 hours West of Spokane.

Participants may camp in their personal tents near a private home where bathroom facilities and showers will be available. Most of the activities will be outdoors at Moses Lake Park.

The cost is just \$35 for the course for registered Venturers who are age 14 to 20 (must not turn 21 until after April 4, 2010) and is limited to 16 participants.

Participants must show evidence of having already completed Kodiak.
