What is **KODIAK?**

Venturing's Nature of Leadership Program (NOL) is designed to develop the Venturer's leadership skills using exciting and fun leadership learning experiences. Phase 1 of NOL is the Venturing Leadership Skills course (VLSC), which covers three leadership skills. Phase 2, called **Kodiak**, is a six-day Venture trek-oriented course providing five leadership skills called commissions.

Phase 3 is the weekend long **Kodiak X**, which reinforces the skills learned in **Kodiak**, and adds two more commissions. Kodiak X is only offered to those who have taken **Kodiak** from several weeks to two years prior. *Phase 3 will NOT be offered during this six-day phase 2 **Kodiak** course.*

Kodiak is oriented around a high adventure trek setting with leadership training and involvement built into the six-day program. The course prepares Venturers to be "servant leaders" as they lead their crew. Servant leadership as a philosophy teaches that the leader works with and through a team to accomplish the mission. The course is designed to be relevant to the participant's life, to become internalized, is based on the servant leader concept, is based on nature, but most of all, it is **FUN!!**

The setting for this years' course is Camp Fife, a 75+ year-old Boy Scout camp in the Grand Columbia Council,

located at Goose Prairie, WA in the Cascade mountains West of Yakima, and not far from Chinook Pass and Mt. Rainier.

Camp Fife is well-suited for this venue. It offers a full range of aquatic activities, with a heated swimming pool, and bus shuttle service to nearby Bumping Lake for boating and long-distance swimming.

A well-stocked First-Aid lodge is in camp and staffed by a full-time medic. The 450 seat dining hall provides excellent dining with plentiful food and choices of entrees at mealtime. The shooting range features .22 cal. rifles, shotguns, black powder, and is .22 cal. pistol ready. A high and low C.O.P.E. course, with full-time C.O.P.E. director, features a climbing and rappelling tower and zip line. Off-site rock climbing is nearby. Multiple hiking trails are available as well as a canoeing or horseback outpost* providing for an overnight stay in the remote forest around Bumping lake including a hot dinner and breakfast served by the Camp Fife staff.

The **Kodiak** commissions are designed to be taught in a trek setting. You design your trek, and the training goes with you! There will be no stuffy classrooms or amphitheater lectures!!

The cost is just \$275* for the week for registered Venturers who are age 14 to 20 (must not turn 21 until after July 11, 2010), and \$100* for adult leaders (over 21).

*Shotgun, .22, and black-powder ammunition. at additional charge. Horseback trek costs \$35 additional. NRA Basic Pistol Course \$10 additional. Hourly charge for water skiing additional.
