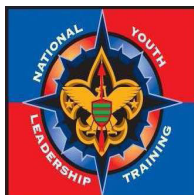

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members of the Boy Scouts of America with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. NYLT is a six-day course held at Camp Scout-A-Vista in Wenatchee. Content is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment. The course is set up to represent a month in the life of a typical Scout Troop. The first three full days of the course represent the first three weeks of a troop calendar, complete with patrol leaders' council meetings and planning for a big troop event. During an NYLT course the team development process is heightened with the patrol members, enabling them to become a highly effective team that can reach its full potential. Along the way, they also enjoy the Scouting fellowship and fun that are key components of the patrol method.
