2009 Lodge Service Award Requirements

TO PROVIDE CHEERFUL SERVICE

1. Participate in 6 hours of an approved service project at a Grand Columbia Council Camp.
2. If you are an Ordeal member of Tataliya Lodge, seal your membership in the Order by attaining Brotherhood membership. If you are already a Brotherhood or vigil Honor member, lead fellow Scouts in a service project at a Council camp or property.
3. Complete six of the following: (circle those completed)
 - a. Serve as an Elangomat at an Ordeal.
 - b. Serve on an Ordeal, Brotherhood, or Vigil ceremonial team.
 - c. Help teach new Scouts camping skills, or improve camping skills including preparation, packing, setting up camp and cooking.
 - d. Advance one rank or palm.
 - e. Participate in the **Scoutreach Mentoring Program** through the Lodge Service Committee.
 - f. Do a camp promotion presentation and a troop/team OA election.
 - g. Serve actively as Lodge Adviser, Lodge Associate Adviser, or as a Chapter Adviser or Chapter Associate Adviser or serve actively as a Chapter Lodge officer. (You may only apply this once per year toward the award.)
 - h. Help plan and lead a campout with your troop.
 - i. Serve as a Troop/Team OA representative for a 12 month period.
 - j. Work as staff (1) at a Camporee or (2) Cub Scout day camp or Resident Camp or (3) at a Grand Columbia Council summer camp.
 - k. Attend a Chapter and Lodge meeting.
 - l. Do at least ONE presentation for the annual Lodge Leadership Development Course.
 - m. Attend a Section W-1C Conclave, a National Leadership Conservation Seminar (NLCS), or attend a high adventure camp.
 - n. Scoutmaster's Choice (please list) _____.
